**Renewal of Philippine passports (Epassport)**- Application for passport will be done **by appointment**. To schedule an appointment for Saskatoon Outreach, please call **Tel Nos. (306) 653-4499** or **653-4488** and look for Ms. Fay Santos-Vargas. For Regina Outreach, please contact **Tel Nos. (306) 359-5859** or **581-9332** or email [lisa.palmer31@gmail.com](mailto:lisa.palmer31@gmail.com) and look for Ms. Lisa Palmer. Be ready to state the complete name of each applicant.

- Applicants who show up at the Center without appointment may be accommodated and could be given a time slot on a **first-come, first-served** basis in lieu of “no-show” applicants or between appointments or after 10:00 p.m, if feasible.

A handwritten signature in black ink, appearing to be a stylized 'J' or similar character.

- Applicants who arrive late for their appointments may still be accommodated, only after those who were given appointments for that particular hour shall have been served.
- Applicants are requested to accomplish the application form for the renewal of passport prior to their appointment. Forms can be downloaded from this site [http://www.philcongen.toronto.com/consular/consular\\_passport.php](http://www.philcongen.toronto.com/consular/consular_passport.php); forms will also be made available during the consular outreach at PCCM.

### **REQUIREMENTS FOR E-PASSPORT APPLICATION**

- Applicant should have a VALID passport;
- If passport has expired, applicant must present a VALID work permit or a VALID permanent resident card (PRC), or any proof that Canadian citizenship has not been granted /obtained;
- Photocopy of data page of latest passport where photo is affixed;
- Standard-sized pre-paid NATIONAL Xpresspost envelope will be required for a family/group of more than four (4) applicants;
- Fee of C\$69.00 must be paid in **cash only** . (No credit cards or debit cards are accepted).

The biometric capture of data, fingerprint/s photo and signature of each applicant is a long process. We ask for your patience while waiting for your turn.

**Due to the large number of applications for the ePassport, the applicant will receive the new ePassport and old passport after two (2) to three (3) months from the date of filing of the application.**

### **OTHER SERVICES OFFERED**

- 1. Notarization of Documents** – Bring your document and personally sign it before one of the members of the consular team. Requirements: photocopy of valid passport and fee of \$ 28.75.
- 2. Authentication of NBI Clearance applications** – Fingerprinting will be done by the team. Requirements: One (1) colored passport-sized photo with white background taken not more than three (3) months ago and fee of \$28.75.
- 3. Consultation on Dual Citizenship/Administration of Oaths of Allegiance to the Republic of the Philippines** – Applicants are encourage to submit application and requirements to the Philippine Consulate in Toronto for review before the service date of the consular outreach. Applicants will be informed of the schedule of oath-taking during the outreach. Fee is \$57.50 and for unmarried minor (below 18 years old) children of applicant, fee is \$ 28.75.
