With less than two weeks before our October 30 registration deadline, I renew my call for members of the Filipino-Canadian community throughout Canada to join me in the forthcoming Winter Escapade – It's More Fun in the Philippines (WE-IMFIT PH) tour set for 18-24 January 2014.

Our itinerary now includes a sixth destination, Roxas City in Capiz where a sumptuous seafood spread and folklore-spiced guided tour awaits. This one-of-a-kind tour package also promises a relaxing stay in breathtaking Boracay, an extraordinary Ati-Atihan experience in Kalibo, a preview of the colorful Dinagyang Festival and a tourism show in Iloilo, and island hopping in Guimaras. In Manila, we are hoping to pay a courtesy call on His Excellency, President Benigno S. Aquino III.

- 1. Call the Philippine Embassy in Ottawa or your nearest Consulate General, Department of Tourism Office or Honorary Consular Office for basic guidance, referral to the Rajah Tours and/or booking agents in Canada and online registrationat www.winterescapadeph.com.
- 2. A deposit of CAD 200 per person upon registrationis required to guarantee participation. The deadline for registration is on 30 October 2013. Late registration is possible but subject to room availability and best guoted hotel and airline rates.
- 3. Full payment deadline is on 5 November 2013. Payments by cheque or bank deposit are preferred. A 4% surcharge will be applied on credit card payments to be computed in US dollars.
- 4. Registration changes or cancellations must be made not later than 5 November 2013 to qualify for a 50% refund. There will be no refunds for cancellations made after 5 November 2013.
- 5. Participants may book their international flight with any travel agent. Please ensure that your international flight will connect with the domestic flight departing from Manila to Kalibo at 08:15 a.m.on January 18. Participants already in Manila before January 18 may proceed to NAIA to catch the Manila-Kalibo domestic flight included in the basic package arranged by Rajah Tours(sales@rajahtours.com.ph).


